Have your say on next phase of Tolvaddon Business Park

An open afternoon next Thursday (13th, 3-8pm) will give local residents and workers the chance to find out more about the planned expansion of Tolvaddon Business Park.

Several organisations are involved in the development, including the Aspire Project, which promotes sustainable energy in remote parts of Europe. Project co-ordinator Paula Hichens said: "Isolated regions like West Cornwall will be the first to suffer as fossil fuels run out. One way to tackle this problem is to make sure that all new buildings use sustainable energy sources for their heat and light."

According to Tim German of Cornwall Sustainable Energy Partnership, this will give a boost to businesses operating there: "In a world of ever-rising fuel prices, an office heated by natural resources is a real asset. This development gives Tolvaddon Business Park the opportunity to become a flagship for the low carbon economy."

The development is at an early stage and this is the first of several consultations that will take place before designs are finalised. The event will take place in the offices of Community Energy Plus from 3-8pm and will give the community the opportunity to influence the key features of the site, such as the inclusion of a safe footpath to Pool School.
